

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

Compassion: Coming to the rescue

First we are going to hear a reading from the Bible. It is a story Jesus told to a crowd of people, some of whom would have been shepherds.

The Lost Sheep Luke 15:4-6

Jesus said “Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them – what do you do? You leave the other ninety-nine sheep in the pasture and go looking for the one that was lost until you find it.

When you find it, you are so happy that you put it on your shoulders and carry it back home.

Then you call your friends and

neighbours and say to them,

‘I am so happy I found my lost sheep. Let us celebrate!’”



Barney: Bella, you were late today. What happened?

Bella: Well, on the way to school we saw a little boy wandering around on the pavement. He was only about two and he was starting to really cry. I said to my mum, we must do something or he might wander into the road.

Barney: Gracious! What did she do?

Bella: Well, she told me to hold his hand and try to find out his name. Then she went into the nearest shop to look for his mum.

Barney: Did she find her?

Bella: No, but in the Newsagents she found his Granny. She hadn't even realized he'd gone!

Barney: I know what that's like. My little cousin runs off really quickly when you turn your back for 2 seconds! The boy's Granny must have been shocked when she found out.

Bella: Yes, she was. She was nearly as upset as the little boy. He was called Simon.

I felt so sorry for him. He didn't know where he was or what was happening.

Barney: Thank goodness you came along at the right time and it was a happy ending!



Think back to the Bible reading.

We heard about a lamb that was lost. He was probably hungry and cold, afraid and lonely. But the shepherd came looking for him because he cared about the sheep and wanted to help. We call this showing compassion.

Bella and her Mum felt compassion too, when they found little Simon. Compassion led them to help, even though it made Bella late for school.



How does it make you feel when you see someone who is upset or lost or fed up?



These are feelings of compassion. They move us to do things that help others in need.

Responding



Jesus told the parable about the Lost Sheep because he wants us to know that he is like the Good Shepherd who comes to the rescue. He will always show compassion and kindness towards us when we are in need.
