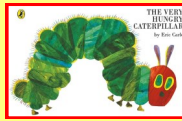
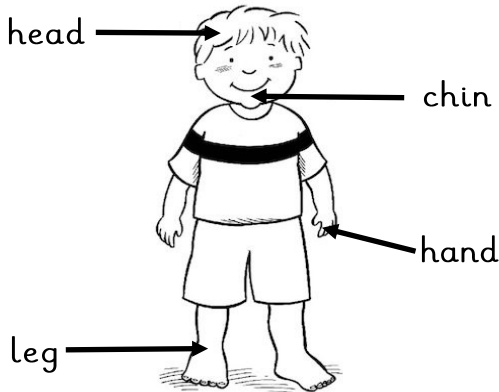




Writing to inform:

Sentences tell us something. They start with a capital letter and finish with a full stop.



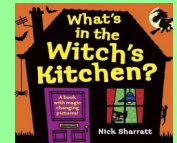
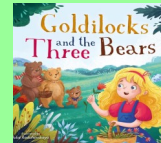
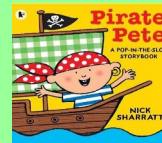
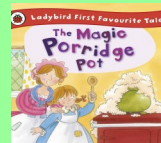
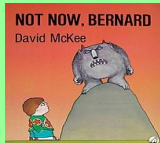

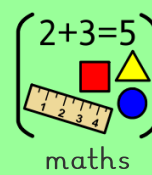
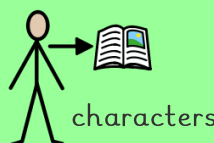
Retelling a story: Tell the main events in the order they happened.
