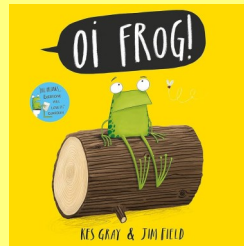
Writing to entertain:

Regular plural noun suffixes -s or -es for example, dog, dogs; wish, wishes.

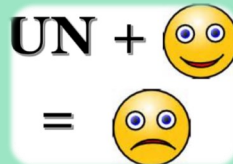
Including the effects of these suffixes on the meaning of the noun

Suffixes

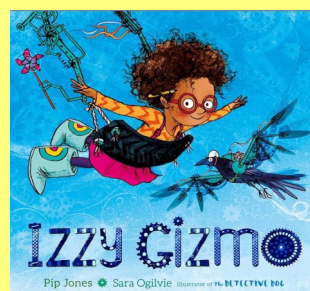
Suffixes that can be added to verbs where no change is needed in the spelling of root words (e.g. helping, helped, helper)

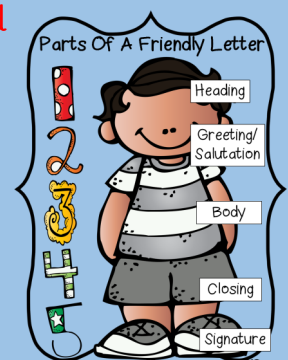
