

<u>Prior Learning</u>

Know that Jewish people believe in God and call him Chanukah.

<u>Concepts</u>

Belief - I recognise that a belief is a firm thought that something is true.

Worship- I know that worship is an act of religious devotion and may be performed in a number of different ways.

Acceptance - I respect and accept the views and beliefs of others.

<u>Key Vocabulary</u>

Jewish - a belief in one God and an important believer called Abraham. Sabbat - the seventh day of the week to rest on.

mezuzah - a piece of parchment with a religious text written on it. **challah bread** - a special plaited bread eaten on special occasions.

sedar plate - a plate that holds 5 or 6 items to represent Passover.

Chanukah or Hanukkah – a winter festival of lights.

Synagogue—A Jewish place of worship.
